## 2011 Summer School

Take up to 12 hours of classes onsite and/or online. Room & board are optional for onsite courses. Federal Financial Aid is available for those who qualify.

#### REGISTRATION:

Students may officially register for summer courses starting February 1. Make an appointment with the Registrar to sign up. Registration must be accompanied by payment, funds on account, or financial aid.

#### INDEPENDENT STUDIES:

With permission of the instructor & the VP of Academics, independent studies may be taken. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 is required. One course in each division (biblical, general, professional) is allowed.

#### COSTS:

Each course (onsite, online, or independent study) costs **\$400**.

Summer room & board may be added for **\$200** (3 meals per weekday May 14-28).

Retake fees of **\$300** apply for courses that have been previously dropped or failed.

Field Education Experience for summer school costs **\$600** for 6 hours of credit.
