



Full Time Faculty Position in Christian Counseling

Central Christian College of the Bible invites applications for a full-time faculty position in Christian Counseling to begin July 1, 2012.

Responsibilities

Teach a full-time load (up to 27 hours per year) of counseling and psychology courses in some combination of traditional semester-long courses, online courses, and intensive courses.

Advance the Christian Counseling program by forming relationships with mental health agencies and officials, supporting recruitment activities for the program, assisting graduates with transitions into graduate school, and enhancing curricular and assessment activities of the program.

Serve as the director of the Kingdom Counseling Center, which serves student and community clients.

Supervise counseling internship students.

Engage in academic advisement with Christian Counseling students.

Engage in non-instructional activities such as representing the college in various settings, church involvement, cross-cultural mission trips, scholarship, professional development, and significant engagement in the lives of students.

Qualifications

Master's degree in counseling is required. Terminal degree (Ph.D. or equivalent) in a relevant area of counseling and/or ministry is preferred.

The successful candidate will have a combination of graduate credentials that qualify him or her to teach in both counseling and psychology (i.e. a master's in counseling and a Ph.D. in psychology or vice versa. Alternatively, the candidate could have a graduate degree in Christian counseling at least 18 graduate semester hours in psychology.)

Candidate must have a minimum of three (3) years successful teaching experience at the collegiate level or above or professional ministry involvement. State licensure as a professional counselor in Missouri or another state through reciprocity is preferred.

Active member of the Christian Churches/Churches of Christ (Restoration Movement).
