Diversity

The most recent student diversity numbers were reported for the fall semester 2016. Female students comprised 40.5% of the student body. Male students comprised 59.4% of the student body. Ethnic groups were self-reported with the following results: American Indian/Alaskan 0.42%; Asian 0.42%; African American/Black 8.37%; Hispanic 4.60%; Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander 0.42%, Two or More Races 4.60%; White 79.92%, Unknown 1.26%. For the 2015-2016 academic year, 58.7% of students received a Pell Grant.

Retention

The most recent retention rates calculated from IPEDS show a full time retention rate of 65% for first-time full time freshmen entering in the fall of 2014.

Completion

Based on the experience of the first-time full-time degree seeking freshman classes who began their studies in 2009, using a completion standard involving a time frame of 150 percent of published time (a four-year program taking no more than six years to complete, the 2009 completion rate is 36%. Percentage of Full-time, First-time Students Who Graduated in the Specified Amount of Time and Began in Fall 2007 or Fall 2009 was 38%.

Placement

Bachelor's degree recipients in the classes of 2008-2015 indicated the following plans post-graduation:

- 36% Enter or remain in paid ministry positions
- 24% Pursue a further degree outside/beyond CCCB (Seminary, University, etc.)
- 14% Plan to enter the mission field
- 22% Work and serve as a volunteer in ministry/work alongside of spouse
